ROUND ROBIN EVENTS

METHOD OF DETERMINING STANDINGS IN A GROUP

- 1. Each player shall play all the others in his group
- 2. The final standings of each group shall be determined by the following priority:
 - a) Greatest number of wins
 - b) Head to head results (if only two players are tied)
 - c) Highest percentage of sets won
 - d) Highest percentage of games won
 - e) Draw by lot

When a match is played with a deciding Match Tie-break instead of a final set, this Match Tiebreak shall count as a set won or lost by 1 game to 0 for the purposes of the above calculation. The score should be recorded as in the following examples:

3-6, 6-4, [10-8] 7-6(3), 6-7(6), [12-10]

3. If a number of runners-up from the initial stages are required, these places shall be allocated as follows: Highest percentage of wins out of matches played. If two or more players are equal, the percentage of sets won to sets played by these players shall be reckoned. If two or more players are still equal, the percentage of games won to games played shall be reckoned. If this fails to break the tie, a play-off or draw by lot shall be the final alternative.
