BALLS	Slazenger Wimbledon 'Special Select' ball
MATCH FORMAT	Best of three tie-break sets
BALL CHANGE	7 / 9 (6 balls in play)
CLOTHING & FOOTWEAR	Players are required to wear almost entirely white recognised tennis clothing. Tennis shoes must conform to the Official Grand Slam Rule Book 2023.
COMPETITOR / GUEST PASSES	Available from the Referee's Office in Aorangi Park – these must be worn at all times whilst on-site and are non-transferable. Please notify the Tournament Director in advance of names for coach/guest passes.
ACCESS TO GROUNDS	All access to Aorangi Park via Gate 1D (Church Road) from Southfields.
CAR PARK	There is no car parking available on site
SPECTATORS	Please note that this event is not open to the general public.
