

**THE WIMBLEDON CHAMPIONSHIPS – Club Ballot Guidelines**

**Monday 22 June – Sunday 5 July 2009**

1. All affiliated clubs shall be allocated a number of pairs of tickets based on the number of their club members who signed up to free British Tennis Membership by the 30 November 2008. The amount of tickets available in each county is also dependent on the number of club members who signed up to British Tennis Membership within their county.
2. All tickets shall be distributed fairly across all clubs as per their percentages within the county.
3. Clubs with no members with British Tennis Membership as at 30 November 2008 shall not receive any pairs of tickets.
4. All tickets allocated to a club must be distributed through a transparent and fairly run ballot and clubs are not permitted to charge an individual a fee for entering into their club Wimbledon ticket ballot (“Club Ballot”).

5. All tickets allocated to a club are to be distributed in pairs.
6. All club members that are current British Tennis Adult and Junior members (9 and over) at the time of the running of the ballot are eligible for inclusion in the Club Ballot.
7. Clubs should request a current list of their British Tennis Members prior to running their Club Ballot by contacting the British Tennis Membership team.
8. No British Tennis Child members (8 and under) are permitted to enter the Club Ballot.
9. All British Tennis Adult and Junior members should be allowed to opt out of entering the Club Ballot.
10. Any British Tennis Adult or Junior members that require wheelchair access to The Championships, should request to be included in the centrally run British Tennis Membership Wimbledon Wheelchair Ballot, by sending a postcard by 28 February 2009, listing their membership number, name and address, email address and contact telephone number, to British Tennis Membership Wheelchair Ticket Ballot, National Tennis Centre, 100 Priory Lane, London, SW15 5JQ or by emailing [membership@lta.org.uk](mailto:membership@lta.org.uk).
11. If a club member has signed up to British Tennis Membership on or after the 1 December 2008 they **are** permitted to enter the Club Ballot. Clubs can request a list of current members to include those that have signed up since this date at any point prior to running the Club Ballot as set out in point 7 above.
12. Club members who are not British Tennis Members are not permitted to enter the Club Ballot.

13. Any winner of a pair of tickets in a Club Ballot must be a current member at that club and signed up to British Tennis Membership (Adult or Junior) on the date that the Club Ballot takes place, at the time of purchase, and at the time of visiting the event.
14. Any winner of a pair of tickets in a Club Ballot must use the tickets for themselves with a guest. The guest does not have to be a British Tennis Member.
15. Any winner of a pair of tickets in the Club Ballot that is under the age of 16 on the date that the Club Ballot takes place must have permission from a parent/guardian in order to purchase the tickets and be accompanied by an adult when he/she attends The Championships.
16. A British Tennis Member may only win a maximum of one pair of tickets through the Club Ballot.
17. No tickets should be given away or used outside of the Club Ballot for example as a prize in any raffle, tombola, etc.
18. If the Club Ballot is held during a club event and a member is unable to attend the event but wishes to be included within the ballot, then their name must be included within the ballot and the member should nominate another member who is present to accept the Wimbledon tickets on his or her behalf.
19. All British Tennis Members that are successful in the Club Ballot must sign and return a copy of the club member ticket form to confirm that they will abide by the conditions of sale and distribution of tickets. Tickets will not be issued without receipt of this form.
20. The timing and cut off date for a Club Ballot is at the discretion of the club but all Club Ballots must be held prior to 1 June 2009.
