RULES & CONDITIONS

1. The Tournament is sanctioned by the LTA and will be conducted under current rules and regulations (including the Code of Conduct).
2. All competitors must be LTA registered and be available for the duration of the tournament. Players may not enter two tournaments which run over the same period.
3. Entry Forms should be sent to the Tournament Secretary by Monday 9 August 2010. The draw will be done on the TTP.
4. If a competitor withdraws for medical reasons after the draw has been made, a medical certificate may be required.
5. Withdrawal Date – No refund of entry fees for any withdrawals made after the draw has taken place.
6. Matches will be best of three tiebreak sets; 10 and Under events, which will be best of three sets using short sets (tiebreak at 4-4); 9 and under and 8 and under best of three tie breaks.
7. Matches will be played indoors and outdoors and possibly on the clay.
8. Competitors must play in suitable tennis clothing and tennis shoes, i.e. shoes must not have spikes, deep ribbing or raised heels or black soled shoes.
9. Play will start at 8.45am daily and continue until close of play, approximately 6.00pm except on Sundays when play will start at 10.00am.
10. All players will be informed of the time of their first match and should arrive at least 15 minutes before the time given for their match and all subsequent matches. These will be on the web site.
11. Competitors must sign the attendance sheet daily on arrival. They must not leave the centre at any time without the permission of the Referee.
12. Competitors should always check the proposed time of their next match with the Referee. Players should be aware that the weather can affect the proposed timetable and be patient if there are delays in getting matches started.

14. Competitors should be available at all times once their event has passed the date stated above.
15. The Referee will be responsible for the day to day running of the tournament. The decision of the Referee on all matters in connection with the tournament is final. Any complaints must be made in writing, addressed to the Tournament Committee and lodged with the Tournament Secretary within 48 hours of the occurrence.
16. Umpires will not be provided for each match but court supervisors will be on duty at all times.
17. The Committee accept no responsibility whatsoever for loss or damage or injury, however caused. Competitors are strongly advised not to leave valuables unattended.
18. The Committee reserves the right to alter or modify the programme and conditions in any way they think fit, subject to compliance with the Rules and Regulations of the LTA and refuse entry without stating a reason.
19. By entering this tournament the player and parent/guardian consent to the following:
 1. **Doping Statement:** I consent to him/her participating in doping control procedures if selected, undertaken by an independent sampling officer (ISO) appointed by UK Sport.
 2. **Media Statement:** I consent to him/her being involved in any publicity connected with LTA Staged Tournaments, including the media interviews, photographs and TV footage. Please inform the tournament organiser if you do not wish him/her to be involved in publicity.
 3. **LTA Advantage Club Membership record:** I consent to the details provided on this entry form to be used to update the LTA Advantage Club Membership record of the person identified.
