- Deliver 'Big Padel Weekends' as a chance to pick up a Padel bat and try the sports for the first time at your local venue for free
- Identify potential venues to host high level Padel competitions in Wales to promote the sport to new fans and followers
- Work with key partners and sponsors to increase the reach of Padel into local communities



PATHWAY

- Provide performance pathways for juniors and adults competing at a high level, aligned to the LTA pathway for GB
- Guidance and support via the Padel Performance Programme (PPP led by Tom Murray LTA)
- Enhance programmes within venues that provide a clear and structure pathway for both juniors and adults to fulfil their potential
- Provide a comprehensive competition calendar that allows players the opportunity to compete in competitions locally
- Utilising existing performance coach network to supply highquality coaches to support and work alongside players on the performance pathway



TIMELINE

In collaboration with the LTA, we have identified three growth phases for Padel tennis in Wales. These phases will focus on integration & building, accelerating and scaling Padel.


We'll integrate Padel tennis into our day to day activities, programmes and funding as the Governing Body.

We'll accelerate the development of Padel tennis courts across Wales in a proactive manner and develop commercial partnerships to invest into the sport in Wales. We'll scale Padel tennis across the country.

We'll scale leagues, competitions and tournaments as well as performance pathways for adults and juniors.



INTEGRATE & BUILD 2022

Integrate

- Review Tennis Wales governance to reflect Padel participants in the organisation
- Develop a Padel tennis area of the Tennis Wales website and integrate into social channels and content
- Integrate Padel into venue registration, ensuring all venues meet our minimum standards for governance and safeguarding
- Provide training on Padel to colleagues, committee and Board

Build

- Roll out LTA Padel tennis qualifications & training throughout Coach Development Centre
- Provide insight, costs and facility information to venues, coaches and operators interested in developing Padel courts at their place to play
- Identify Padel investors and partners to invest into the sport in Wales
- Identify Padel facility aspirations through our national facility survey for Wales and develop a pipeline of projects
- Develop our relationship with the LTA and Sport Wales to invest funding into Welsh Padel court construction
- Identify 'quick win' opportunities to develop Padel courts and programmes to showcase the sport as case studies



ACCELERATE 2023

Accelerate

- Proactively engage potential partners in Wales to develop multiple Padel tennis facilities across the country
- Deliver activation events in key locations to showcase Padel to the public and raise awareness
- Train a pipeline of Padel coaches and officials
- Establish bespoke communication, information and funding to meet the demands of Padel tennis as it grows
- Identify sponsors, partners and investors to generate revenue into the sport to sustain growth

SCALE 2024

Scale

- Deliver dedicated support to Padel venues, operators, coaches and officials
- Grow the number of players, competitors and people coaching and officiating Padel in Wales
- Provide performance pathways for juniors and adults competing at a high level, aligned to the LTA pathway for GB
- Annually increase the number of Padel facilities in Wales, ensuring they continue to meet venue registration standards
- Continue to source external revenue to support the growth of Padel tennis
- Identify high level events to host in Wales that showcase the sport to a wider audience
