



The introduction of the Competition Management System for Play Your Way to Wimbledon is to ensure integrity across all events and to give the organiser visibility of a player's ITF World Tennis Number. **It is a requirement to take player entry via your event on the CMS. It is your responsibility to ensure the players entering your event have an ITF World Tennis Number within the required bandings at the closing deadline.**

### **Ways to Deliver Your Event**

#### **OPTION #1: Tennis Tournament Planner (TTP)**

Tennis Tournament Planner (TTP) supports competition organisers and referees in planning and delivering their tournaments whether that be an internal club tournament, one day event or a large weeklong tournament. TTP enables organisers to manage entry lists, make draws and schedule the tournament all at the click of a few buttons.

#### **OPTION #2: Results Manager**

Easily record results when running internal competitions with Results Manager. This also adds matches to players' accounts ensuring they count towards their WTN.

If you already have Results Manager access set up, no new application is required, just log in to the [Competition Management System](#) and select the **Results Manager** option on the left side of the Home screen.

#### **OPTION #3: "On Paper"**

While it is a requirement that you take entries via the Competition Management System, you are welcome to run your event on the day "on paper", to create the draw and order of play. If you choose this method, matches will not be recorded nor go towards a players' WTN.

Please ensure you note down the winners and runners up details, as you will need to submit this to us to ensure we receive player data to send to County Organisers for the next stage.

### **ACTION REQUIRED: Result Submission for the Next Stage**

Regardless of which option you choose for delivering your event, **all organisers are required to submit their winners and runners up names/details via [this form](#)**. This must be completed by **Tuesday 26<sup>th</sup> May 2026** to secure your players' invitation to the next stage.
