OWN AGE GROUP PRIORITY (APPLICABLE TO ALL GRADES)

Where own age group (OAG) priority has been approved by the LTA Competitions Team, priority acceptance is given to those players whose competition age group is the same as the event e.g. 19 & over.

WILD CARDS

As per the LTA Competition Regulations, 3.20 - 3.22, Wild Cards may be awarded for an event up to a maximum of one (1) place in eight (8) spaces in the draw. Wild cards may be seeded





Acceptances

Where an event is over-subscribed acceptances will be made according to:

- 1. LTA Recent Form¹ (as at the closing deadline)
- 2. In a situation where two or more players have the same Recent Form, players will be drawn by lot

Seeding

Seeding shall be based on the players' LTA Recent Form as at the draw date

¹ Recent Form will be the player's best <u>3</u> individual tournament performance at that ball colour within the last <u>6</u> months.

GRADE 1 – 4 JUNIOR EVENTS

Acceptances

Where an event is over-subscribed acceptances will be made according to:

- 1. LTA Ranking (as at the closing deadline)
- 2. In a situation where two or more players are ranked equally, acceptance order will be drawn by lot

Seeding

Seeding shall be based on the players' LTA Ranking as at the draw date.

GRADE 1 - 4 OPEN EVENTS

Acceptances

Where an event is over-subscribed acceptances will be made according to:

- 1. ITF World Tennis Number (as at the closing deadline)
- 2. If two or more players are equally rated, their LTA Ranking (as at the closing deadline)
- 3. In a situation where two or more players are rated and ranked equally, acceptance order will be drawn by lot

Seeding

Seeding shall be based on the players ITF World Tennis Number followed by LTA Ranking as at the draw date.



GRADE 5 MINI EVENTS

Acceptances

Where an event is over-subscribed acceptances will be made according to:

- 1. Date and time of entry (first come, first served)
- 2. If two or more players enter at exact same time, acceptance will be determined by LTA Recent Form (as at the closing deadline)

Seeding

Seeding shall be based on the player's LTA Recent Form as at the draw date.

GRADE 5 JUNIOR EVENTS

Acceptances

Where an event is over-subscribed acceptances will be made according to:

- 1. Date and time of entry (first come, first served)
- 2. If two or more players enter at exact same time, acceptance will be determined by LTA Ranking (as at the closing deadline)

Seeding

Seeding shall be based on the player's LTA Ranking as at the draw date.

GRADE 5 OPEN EVENTS

Acceptances

Where an event is over-subscribed acceptances will be made according to:

- 1. Date and time of entry (first come, first served)
- 2. If two or more players enter at exact same time, acceptance will be determined by ITF World Tennis Number, then by LTA Ranking (as at the closing deadline)

Seeding

Seeding shall be based on the player's ITF World Tennis Number followed by LTA Ranking as at the draw date.



DOUBLES GRADE 1 - 4 JUNIOR EVENTS

Acceptances

Where a doubles event is oversubscribed, acceptance will give priority to players in the following order:

- 1. 2 players in same age group singles main draw.
- 2. 1 player in same age group singles main draw & 1 player in another age group singles main draw.
- 3. 1 player in same age group singles main draw & 1 reserve or non-entered singles player.
- 4. 2 reserve or non-entered singles players.

Where an event is over-subscribed selections will be made based on the above order of priority and according to:

- 1. Combined domestic age group LTA Ranking (using data available at the time the singles draws were made).
- 2. Where pairings are tied, the pair with the highest LTA Ranked singles player will take precedence.
- 3. By lot where teams are still tied.

For a tournament which only has doubles events, the acceptance priorities will not apply.

Seeding

Seeding shall be based on the players' combined LTA Ranking.

GRADE 5 JUNIOR EVENTS

Acceptances

Where a doubles event is oversubscribed, acceptance will give priority to players in the following order:

- 1. Date and time of entry (first come, first served)¹
- If two or more players enter at exact same time, acceptance will be determined by combined LTA Ranking of players (using data available at the time the singles draws were made)
- 3. If tied the team with the player who has the best LTA Ranking will take precedence
- 4. If still tied players will be drawn by lot

¹The date and time of entry used to determine acceptance is that of the second player in the pair to enter the event.

Seeding

Seeding shall be based on the players' combined LTA Rankings.



GRADE 1 - 4 OPEN EVENTS

Acceptances

Where a doubles event is oversubscribed, acceptance will give priority to players in the following order:

- 1. 2 players in same age group singles main draw
- 2. 1 player in same age group singles main draw & 1 player in another age group singles main draw
- 3. 1 player in same age group singles main draw & 1 reserve or non-entered singles player
- 4. 2 reserve or non-entered singles players

Where an event is over-subscribed selections will be made based on the above order of priority and according to:

- 1. Combined ITF World Tennis Number of players (using data available at the time the singles draws were made)
- 2. If tied the team with the player who has the best ITF World Tennis Number will take precedence
- 3. If still tied players will be drawn by lot

For a tournament which only has doubles events, the acceptance priorities will not apply.

Seeding

Seeding shall be based on the players' combined ITF World Tennis Number

GRADE 5 OPEN EVENTS

Acceptances

Where a doubles event is oversubscribed, acceptance will give priority to players in the following order:

- 1. Date and time of entry (first come, first served)¹
- If two or more players enter at exact same time, acceptance will be determined by combined ITF World Tennis Number of players (using data available at the time the singles draws were made)
- 3. If tied the team with the player who has the best ITF World Tennis Number will take precedence
- 4. If still tied players will be drawn by lot

¹The date and time of entry used to determine acceptance is that of the second player in the pair to enter the event.

Seeding shall be based on the players' combined ITF World Tennis Number
