




- After an absence of 52 years, professional women's tennis will be returning to The Queen's Club in the form of a WTA 500 event


- Year-long planning process which requires regular meetings with all contractors, council & Club on a regular basis
- Detailed schedules and traffic management plans
- Working with our site management and H&S teams
- Mindful of Queen's Club members and residents
- Daily site meetings with contractors

NOISE MANAGEMENT

- Work hard to keep noise to a minimum wherever possible
- Contractor Briefings and daily meetings
- Strict Adherence to Working Hours
- Positioning of skips and generators
- White Noise Reverser Alarms
- Traffic management in place to assist with vehicle movement
- Specific routes into site
- Contact telephone number for a member of the Site Management team during build and break periods.

MANAGING DELIVERIES

Deliveries pre-arranged via online booking system to help manage the traffic



DELIVERY POLICIES

Making full use of all 3 entrances

GREYHOUND ROAD

- Smaller vehicles can only deliver after 9am
- Encouraging deliveries between 10am and 2pm

PALLISER ROAD

- Majority arrive between 5-6am to reduce disruption
- Specialist traffic management company to escort vehicles
- Congestion and noise is minimised

PERHAM ROAD

Access for fixed wheelbase vehicles only

TOURNAMENT PERIOD

TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT

ENSURING MINIMUM DISRUPTION

- Implement best practices and safety policies
- Enforce traffic management plans
- Queue management of spectators to minimise impact on resident access
- Noise Management specialists engaged to monitor noise levels

REGULAR MONITORING

- Quieter, low-emission generators
- Waste management policies
- No music played through PA system before 10:30am



Managed HVM closure between 9am and 10pm for safety and security purposes


Comeragh Road

PALLISER ROAD - QUEUING





Managed HVM closure between 9am and 10pm for safety and security purposes


