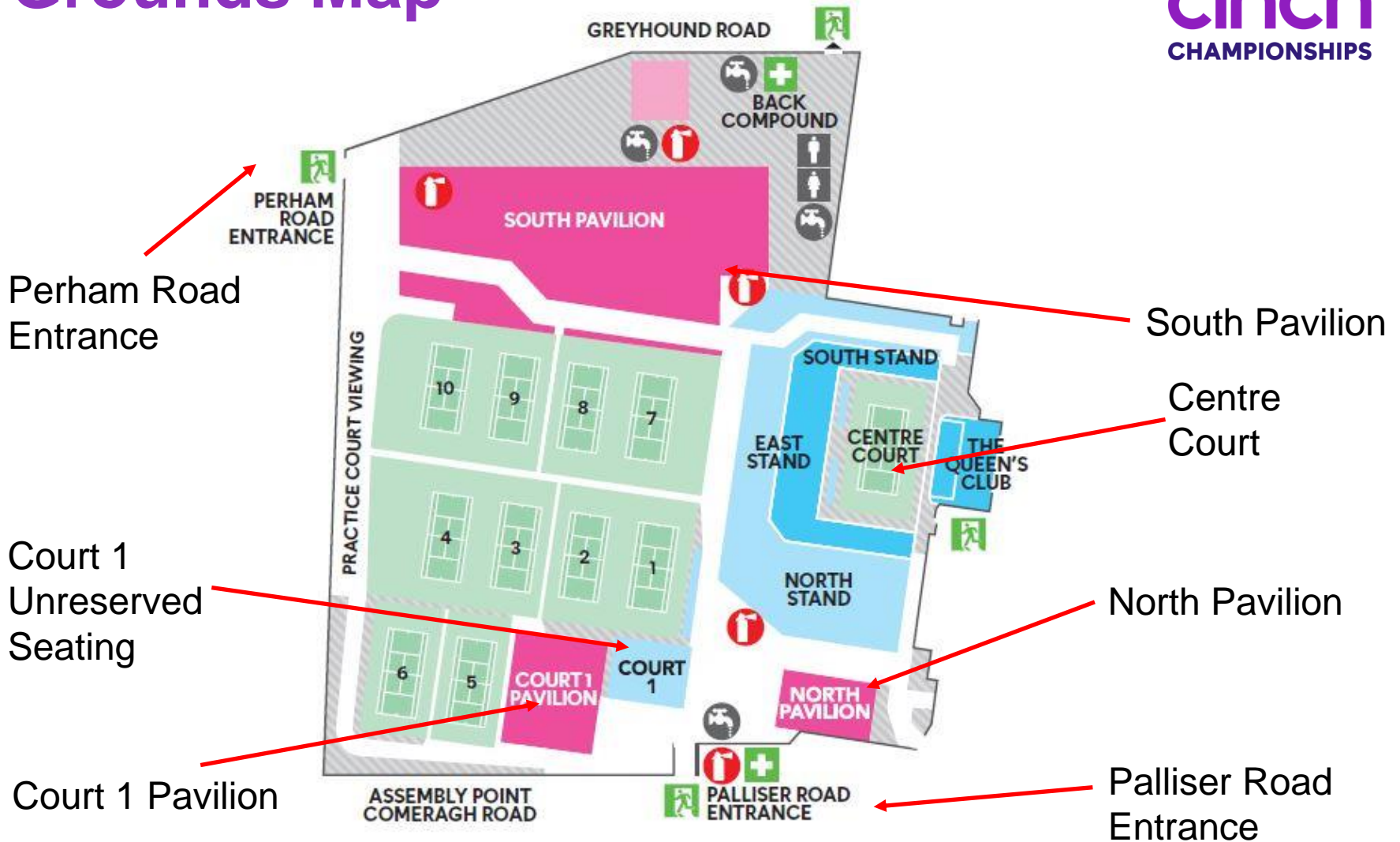

# Build Timings

Working hours are:

Monday to Friday:	<b>8am to 7pm</b>
Saturday:	<b>8am to 1pm</b>
Sunday* and Bank Holidays:	<b>No works</b>

Building in such a tight area requires careful planning:

- Detailed traffic management plan
- Site Manager and Safety Advisors
- The Queen's Club Members
- Daily site meetings with contractors

\* Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> June early breakdown until 10pm as in previous years

# Noise Management – Build & Break

- Positioning of skips and generators
- ‘White Noise’ Reverser alarms
- Strict adherence to working hours
- Additional exit for vehicles on Greyhound Road
- Limited Traffic Management measures in place



# Delivery Policies

## **Aim to make full use of the three entrances**

### **Greyhound Road**

- Smaller vehicles can deliver only after 9am
- Encourage more deliveries between 10am – 2pm

### **Palliser Road**

- Majority arrive between 5-6am to reduce disruption
- Specialist traffic management company escort vehicles
- Congestion and noise is minimised

### **Perham Road**

- Access for fixed wheelbase vehicles only

# TOURNAMENT PERIOD

# Tournament Management

## Ensure minimum disruption

- Implement best practice and safety policies
- Enforce traffic management plans
- Queue management of spectators to minimise impact on resident access
- Monitor noise levels

## Regular monitoring

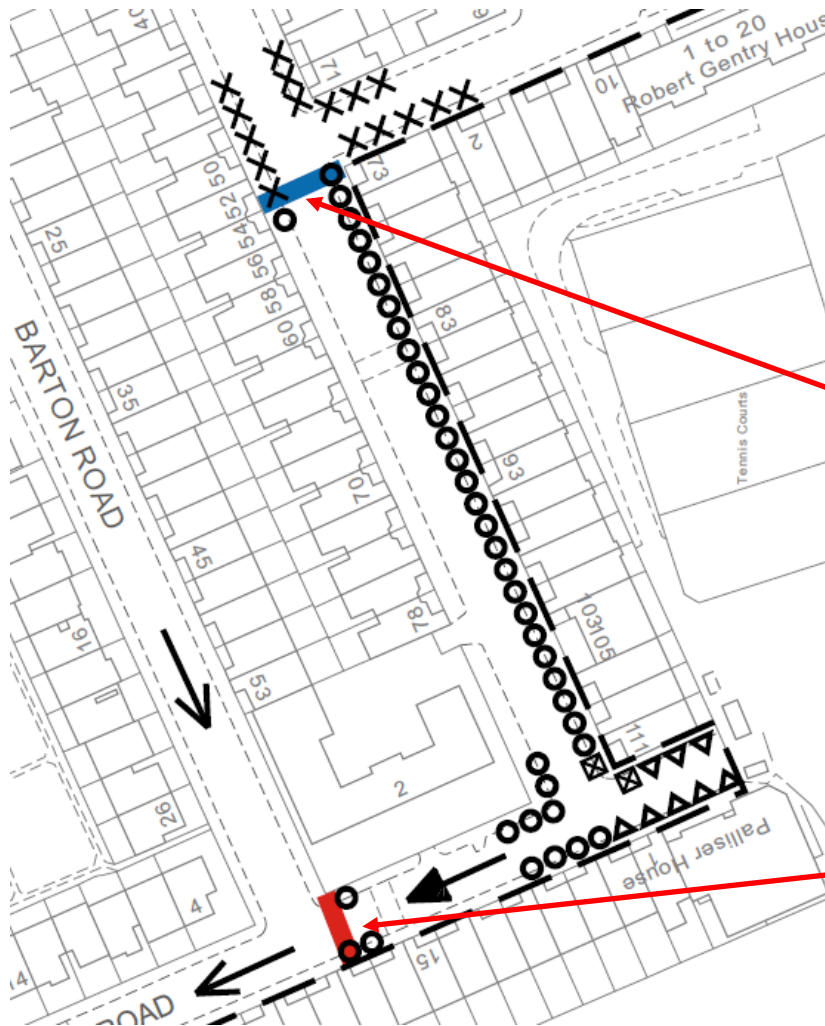
- Quieter, low-emission generators
- Waste Management practices
- Restrict excessive noise from spectators
- No music played through PA systems before 10:30am
- Exit signage

# Traffic Management - Palliser Entrance

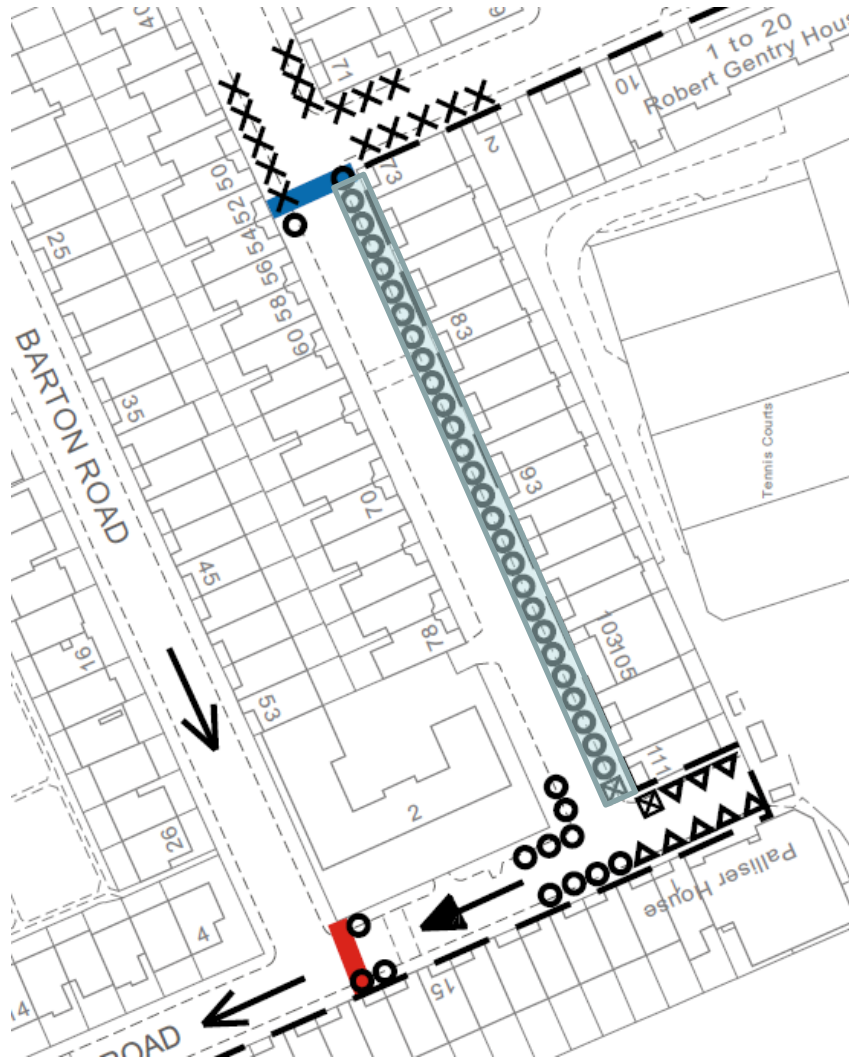


Managed closure 9am –10pm

# Palliser Entrance Queuing



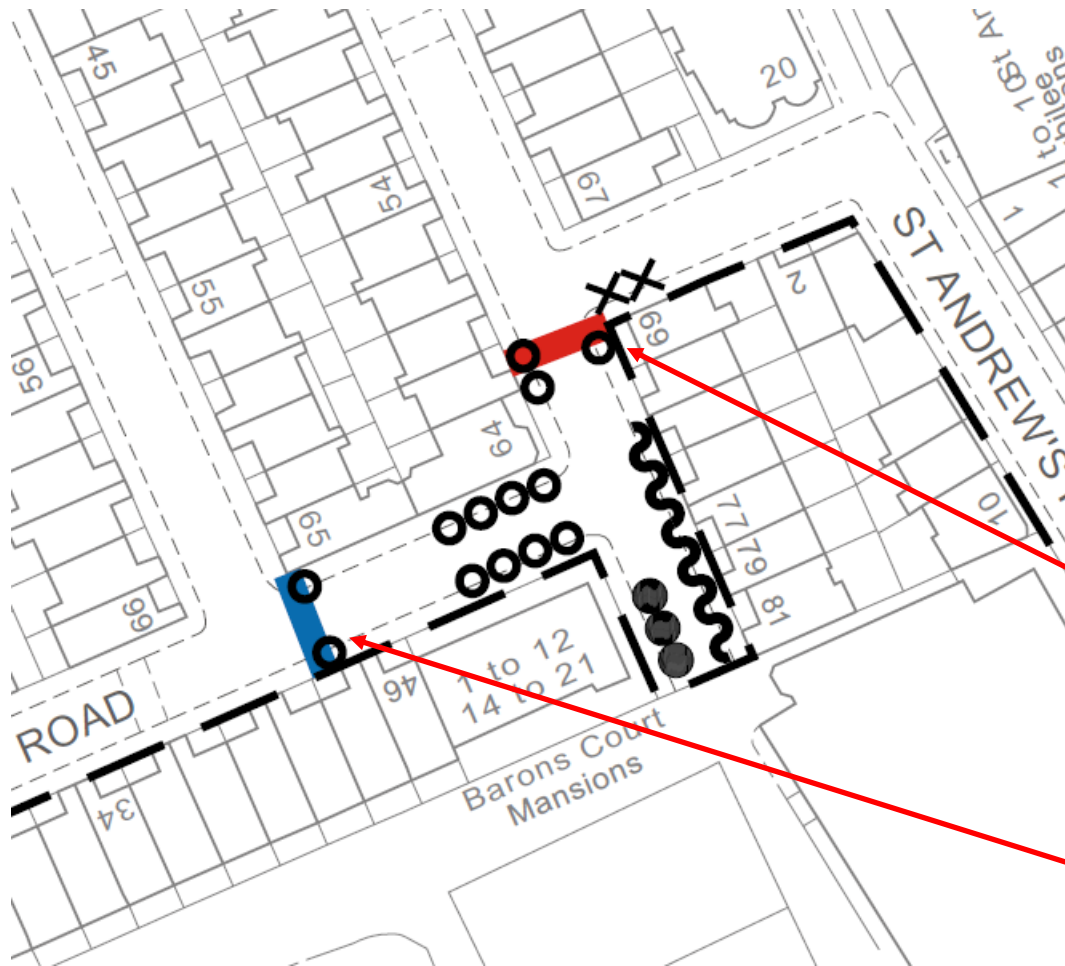
Parking suspensions facilitate:

# Traffic Management – Perham Entrance



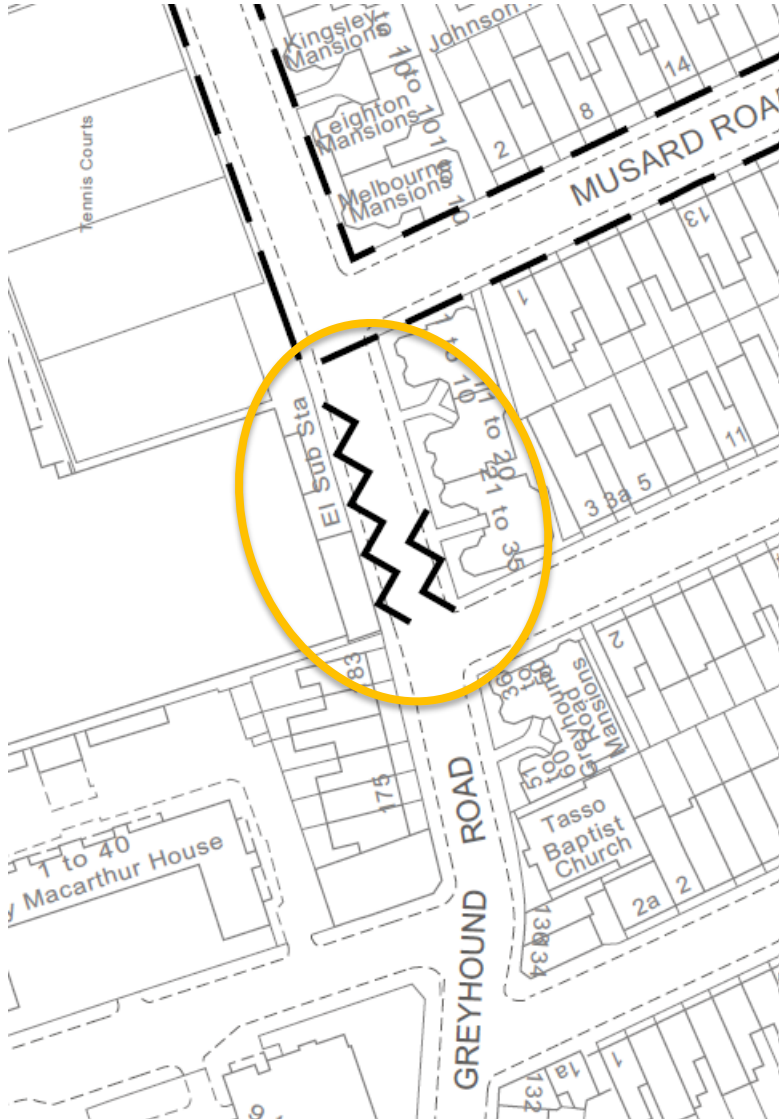
Parking suspensions

## Parking Suspensions

- Short-term waiting bays for official tournament cars
- Maintain traffic flow

# Other Considerations

## Litter

- Work with LBH&F
- Cleaning companies employed
- Recycling policy

## Rain delays

- Spectators may leave later in the evening
- Managed by stewards
- Very small chance of a Monday Final run over
