TOURNAMENT TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT FOR THE 2024 CINCH CHAMPIONSHIPS: 15 – 23 JUNE

The safety and security of all those at and around the cinch Championships is of paramount importance. We work closely with the Metropolitan Police and Council Highways team to improve the safe passage of large vehicles during the build and break-down periods, ensure appropriate safety and security measures are in place during the tournament, and also to minimise disruption to local residents as much as possible.

The following temporary traffic management arrangements will be in operation between Thursday 2 May and Wednesday 17 July. Full details are indicated on the map overleaf. The map is also available, along with important contact numbers, online at www.lta.org.uk/residents-information.

- Various parking suspensions are in place to accommodate the large vehicles involved in the build and break-down periods, and other parking suspensions will facilitate spectator queuing and access during the tournament (see map legend for the dates each type of suspension will be enforced)
- Large lorries will be escorted into The Queen's Club along Palliser Road against the one-way system on various days between Thursday 2 May and Friday 12 July. The majority occur between 5am to 6am, with some ad-hoc escorts in the afternoons
- The Parking Control hours of operation in sections of Zone D and H (marked by the dashed line on map) will be extended to 9am – 7pm from Sunday 16 to Sunday 23 June. If there are parking spaces available, you will be able to drive through the road closures marked in blue when directed by the security stewards. Unfortunately, residents' visitors will not be able to park within the closures. For information visit www.lbhf.gov.uk/parking/parking-permits/visitor-permits or call 020 7371 5678
- Palliser Road (between Comeragh Road and Barton Road) will be one-way, northbound to all traffic from Sunday 16 to Sunday 23 June to ease vehicle flow.

On recommendation from the Metropolitan Police, four road closures with physical security measures will be in place from 9am – 10pm from Sunday 16 to Sunday 23 June inclusive. The measures deployed will be similar to those used in 2023 and will have no impact on pedestrians. We will be holding an event at the club on the 16th June, so the security measures will be in place on this day, one day earlier than in previous years on Comeragh Road and Palliser Road only. - Comeragh Road (between the junctions with Gledstanes Road and Palliser Road)
- Palliser Road (between the junctions with The Queen's Club and Barton Road)
- Perham Road (between the junctions with Gledstanes Road and St Andrew's Road) (not Sunday 16th June)
- Gledstanes Road (between the junctions with Perham Road and Fairholme Road). (not Sunday 16th June)

To show our continued appreciation for your patience and understanding, eligible residents can register for complimentary evening ground admission for themselves plus one guest each on multiple evenings between Monday 17 and Friday 19 June (inclusive). Residents will be given entry from 5pm, via the queue at the Perham Road Entrance. The registration period for evening ground admission runs from 10am Thursday 2 May to 10am Sunday 16 June.
