

# RECRUIT A YOUNG PERSON'S *WELFARE* AMBASSADOR



**Young Person's Welfare Ambassadors, or YPWAs, are young people aged 14–24 who play an important role in promoting safeguarding within their venues. The 12-month programme supports YPWAs to:**

- Raise awareness of safeguarding and welfare issues amongst members and players
- Gather feedback and become a voice for young people
- Provide an important link between venue committees and children and young people

## BENEFITS TO YOU AND YOUR VENUE

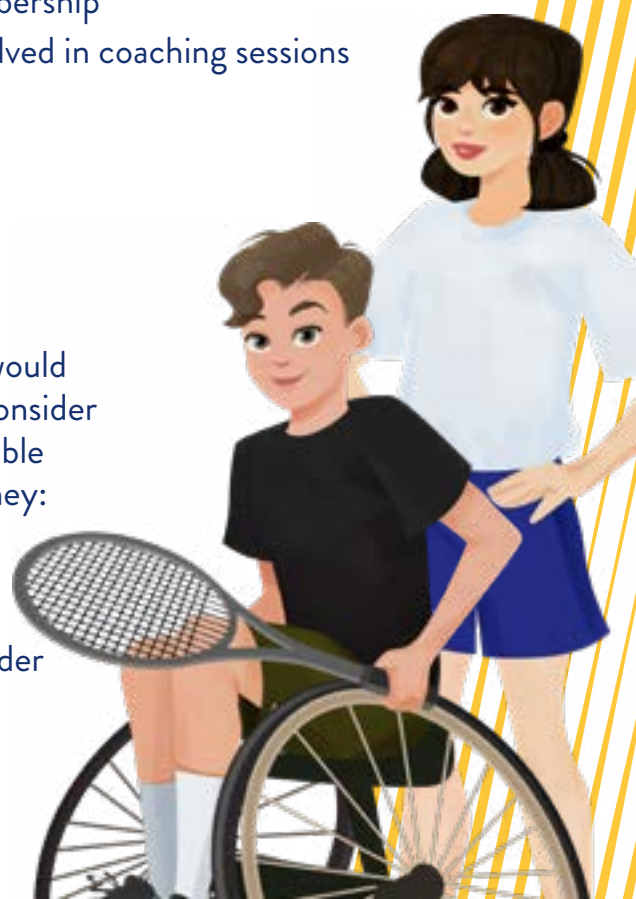
- Support the venue in meeting the safeguarding standards required for LTA venue registration
- Develop better relationships with your junior members
- Happier children means more retention, helping to future proof your venue
- Be recognised as leading the way in safeguarding helping attract a higher membership interest from other children, young people and families
- Promotion of your venue and potential increase in membership
- Support children and young people who are already involved in coaching sessions or as Tennis Leaders
- Access to further training opportunities

## HOW TO RECRUIT

You may already have someone who springs to mind who would love to take part in this opportunity, or you may want to consider an application process within your venue to identify a suitable young person. When identifying someone please ensure they:

- Are aged between 14–24 years
- Understand the role and expectations
- Have consent from their parent or carer if aged 17 or under

If aged 16 or over, they will require a volunteer DBS check gained through the LTA.

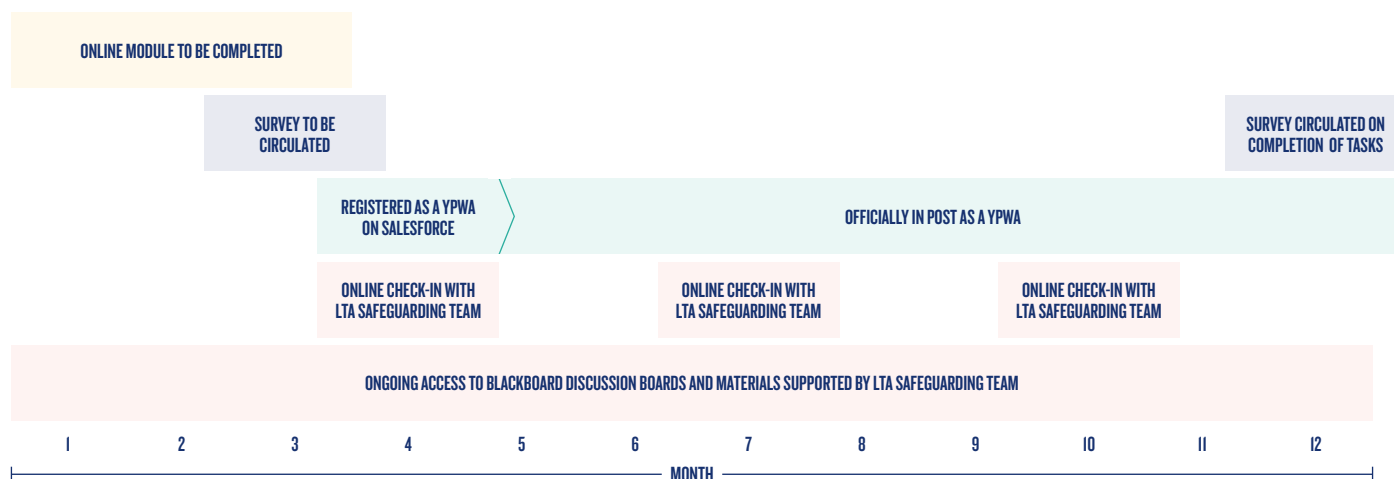
## WHAT IT ENTAILS
