

HSBC Championships – Friday, June 13, 2025

- Last time top 4 seeds in semi-final of WTA Tour event **on grass** was 2009 Wimbledon – Safina, S. Williams, V. Williams, Dementieva.
- Last time top 3 seeds in semi-final of WTA Tour event **on grass** was 2019 Mallorca.
- Last time top 4 seeds in semi-final at any WTA Tour event was 2023 Charleston. Before that it was 2017 Monterrey.
- 1st time ever top 5 seeds in quarter-final of WTA 500 event **on grass**.
- 1st time top 5 seeds in quarter-final of any WTA Tour event **on grass** since 2019 Mallorca. Before that it was 2010 Birmingham.
- Top 4 seeds reached semi-final of WTA 500 event on 3 occasions – 2012 Stuttgart, 2014 Brisbane, 2023 Charleston.
- Last time top 2 seeds lost in WTA Tour quarter-final **on grass** was 2017 Eastbourne. Before that it was 2000 Eastbourne.
- Last time top 3 seeds lost in WTA Tour quarter-final on any surface was 2012 Cincinnati. Last time **on grass** was 2000 Eastbourne.
- Last time top 4 seeds lost in WTA Tour quarter-final on any surface was 2001 Hobart. Last time **on grass** was 2000 Eastbourne.

DIANA SHNAIDER highlights

- 14th WTA Tour quarter-final, and 3rd of 2025.
- 3rd WTA Tour quarter-final on grass – reached two last year (Birmingham, Bad Homburg).
- 5th WTA 500 quarter-final. Since Bad Homburg last year, only Emma Navarro (6th here this week) reached more WTA 500 quarter-finals than her.
- Bids to reach 11th WTA Tour semi-final, and 1st of 2025.
- Bids to reach 2nd WTA Tour semi-final on grass (WTA 500 Bad Homburg last year).
- Bids to reach 4th WTA 500 semi-final.
- Owns 1-8 win-loss record against top 10 players – only victory has come against WR-2 Coco Gauff at Toronto last year.
- Won 4 WTA Tour titles – all last year – including one on grass (WTA 500 at Bad Homburg).
- Achieved career-high ranking of No. 11 in May.
- Won girls' doubles title at 2021 Wimbledon alongside partner Kristina Dmitruk.

MADISON KEYS highlights

- 55th WTA Tour quarter-final, 12 years after her first.
- 6th WTA Tour quarter-final of 2025, which equals her highest number of quarter-finals in a season since 2016.
- 9th WTA Tour quarter-final on grass.
- Bids to reach 13th WTA 500 semi-final, which would make her top of list of most WTA 500 semi-finals by Americans since level introduced in 2009 (currently level with S. Williams and Pegula on 12).
- Bids to reach 32nd WTA Tour semi-final, and 4th of 2025, which would be her highest number of semi-finals in a season since 2016.
- Bids to reach 5th WTA Tour semi-final on grass (previously 3 at Eastbourne and 1 at Birmingham).
- Defeated lefthander Angelique Kerber in 2014 Eastbourne final.
- Reigning Australian Open champion – maiden Grand Slam title. It was her 46th major appearance – only Flavia Pennetta (49 major appearances to win 2015 US Open) and Marion Bartoli (47 major appearances to win 2013 Wimbledon) have taken longer to claim 1st Grand Slam title.
- Won 10 WTA Tour titles, including 3 on grass (2014, 2023 Eastbourne and 2016 Birmingham).
- Best performance at Wimbledon is two quarter-finals (2015, 2023).
- Achieved career-high ranking of No. 5 in February, when cracked top 10 for 1st time since August 2019.

TATJANA MARIA

- 22nd WTA Tour quarter-final, and 2nd of 2025 (Bogota).
- 4th WTA Tour quarter-final on grass, and 1st since 2022 Wimbledon, when defeated compatriot Jule Niemeier. Owns 3-0 win-loss record in WTA Tour quarter-finals on grass.
- 1st German to reach WTA Tour quarter-final on grass since herself and Niemeier, 2022 Wimbledon.
- 1st ever WTA 500 quarter-final.
- Bids to reach 10th WTA Tour semi-final, and 1st in 2 years (Cleveland).
- Bids to reach 4th WTA Tour semi-final on grass (2018 Mallorca, 2019 Birmingham, 2022 Wimbledon).
- Bids to become 1st German to reach WTA 500 semi-final since Angelique Kerber, 2019 Osaka.
- Bids to become 4th qualifier to reach WTA 500 semi-final in 2025, after Polina Kudermetova (Brisbane), Emiliana Arango and Daria Saville (both Merida).
- At 37 years and 311 days, is slightly older than Serena Williams when Serena reached final at 2019 Wimbledon.
- Last qualifier to reach semi-final of WTA 500 event on grass was Viktoriya Tomova, 2024 Bad Homburg.
- Owns 9-45 win-loss record against top 20 players. Defeated WR-14 Muchova in R2 this week, which ended 16-match losing streak against top 20 players.
- Bids to win back-to-back matches against top 20 players for 1st time since semi-final run at 2022 Wimbledon, when downed WR-5 Maria Sakkari and WR-17 Jelena Ostapenko.
- 3rd in list of most matches played in WTA Tour history (1,240) – only Navratilova (1,661) and Evert (1,455) played more. Played 1st match on Tour in 2005.
- Won 3 WTA Tour titles (2018 Mallorca on grass, 2022 & 2023 Bogota).
- Achieved career-high ranking of No. 42 in January 2024.
- Best result at Grand Slams is reaching semi-finals at 2022 Wimbledon, falling to Ons Jabeur.

ELENA RYBAKINA

- 50th WTA Tour quarter-final, and 5th of 2025.
- 7th WTA Tour quarter-final on grass.
- 19th WTA 500 quarter-final.
- Bids to reach 33rd WTA Tour semi-final, and 4th of 2025.
- Bids to reach 5th WTA Tour semi-final on grass, including twice at Wimbledon.
- Bids to reach 12th WTA 500 semi-final, and 3rd of 2025. If wins, since 2024 no one has reached more semi-finals at this level than her (will be 6th – level with Alexandrova, Kasatkina and Pegula).
- Since 2024 no one won more WTA 500 titles than her (4).

- Owns 23-2 win-loss record on grass against players ranked outside top 50.
- 2022 Wimbledon champion, defeating Ons Jabeur in final.
- Won 9 WTA Tour titles, including 4 at WTA 500 level.
- Won one title this year, at WTA 500 Strasbourg on clay last month.

Andy Murray Arena - Match 3

[1] Qinwen Zheng (WR5 - CHN) v [WC] Emma Raducanu (WR37 – GBR)

Head to Head: First meeting.

QINWEN ZHENG highlights

- 23rd WTA Tour quarter-final, and 6th of 2025.
- 6th WTA 500 quarter-final. Owns 4-1 win-loss record in WTA 500 quarter-finals.
- 1st ever quarter-final on grass at any level. 1st Chinese player to reach WTA Tour quarter-final on grass since Zhu Lin, 2023 Birmingham, who reached semi-final.
- Bids to reach 15th WTA Tour semi-final, and 2nd of 2025 (Rome).
- Bids to reach 5th WTA 500 semi-final, and 1st outside Asia.
- Won just 4 matches on grass (including 2 at 2022 Wimbledon) with 4-8 win-loss record.
- Won 5 WTA Tour titles, including 1 at WTA 500 level (2024 Tokyo – last time she was No. 1 seed at a tournament before this week).
- Olympic champion last year, defeating Donna Vekic in final.
- Fell to Aryna Sabalenka in 2024 Australian Open final, becoming 2nd Chinese to reach Grand Slam final, after Li Na. Reached final at 2024 WTA finals, losing to Coco Gauff.
- Fell to Aryna Sabalenka in quarter-finals at Roland Garros.
- Currently at career-high ranking of No. 5.

EMMA RADUCANU highlights

- British Number One again for 1st time in 2 years. Highest ranking in almost 3 years (injuries etc).
- Bids to become 1st British woman to reach Queen's semi-finals since Virginia Wade in 1971.
- 11th WTA Tour quarter-final, and 2nd of 2025 (Miami).
- 3rd WTA Tour quarter-final on grass, after Nottingham and Eastbourne last year.
- 6th WTA 500 quarter-final – only Konta (8) reached more among Brits. 0-5 win-loss record in WTA 500 quarter-finals.
- Bids to reach 4th WTA Tour semi-final, 1st since 2024 Nottingham, and 2nd on grass.
- Bids to reach 1st WTA 500 semi-final, and become 5th British woman to achieve this feat, after Boulter, Keothavong, Konta and Watson.
- Bids to become 1st wild card to reach WTA 500 semi-final on grass since Jelena Ostapenko, 2021 Eastbourne. Only previous British wild card to reach WTA 500 semi-final (on any surface) is Watson (2014, 2017 Eastbourne).
- Owns 3-11 win-loss record against top 10 players. Highest ranked player she has defeated is WR-5 Jessica Pegula at Eastbourne last year.
- Last British woman to win at Queens was Ann Jones in 1969 (also won Wimbledon).
- Won 2021 US Open singles title without dropping a set, becoming 1st qualifier to win Grand Slam singles title, and the 1st British woman to win major singles title since Virginia Wade at 1977 Wimbledon.
- Achieved career-high ranking of No. 10 in July 2022, becoming 5th British woman to achieve this feat, after Wade, Barker, Durie and Konta.
- Since 2021 US Open her best performances have been reaching two WTA Tour semi-finals, at 2022 Seoul and 2024 Nottingham, where she fell to compatriot Katie Boulter.

- In 2021 became youngest British woman to reach R16 of Wimbledon in Open Era.
- Out for nine months from April 2023 to January 2024 following surgery on both wrists and left ankle.

[3] Emma Navarro (WR10 – USA) v [8] Amanda Anisimova (WR15 – USA)

Head to Head: Anisimova leads 3-0

Last meeting: 2025 Charleston Clay QF Anisimova 75 76(1)

1st all-American quarter-final on grass since Gauff defeated Pegula, 2023 Eastbourne.

8th WTA Tour event in 2025 that 3+ American women in quarter-final. It happened only 3 times in 2024.

1st time 3 American women in WTA Tour quarter-final on grass since Gauff, Keys, Pegula – 2023 Eastbourne.

EMMA NAVARRO

- 19th WTA Tour quarter-final, and 6th of 2025.
- 4th WTA Tour quarter-final on grass.
- 9th WTA 500 quarter-final, and 5th in 2025. No one reached more quarter-finals at this level than her in 2025.
- Bids to reach 11th WTA Tour semi-final, and 2nd of 2025 (WTA 500 Merida).
- Bids to reach 2nd WTA Tour semi-final on grass (WTA 500 Bad Homburg last year).
- Bids to reach 6th WTA 500 semi-final.
- Won 2 WTA Tour titles, at 2024 Hobart and at WTA 500 Merida in February.
- Wimbledon quarter-finalist last year, falling to Jasmine Paolini. Also reached semi-finals at US Open last year, falling to Aryna Sabalenka.
- Achieved career-high ranking of No. 8 in September 2024, when 1st cracked top 10.
- Won both previous matches against Americans on grass – last was against Gauff at Wimbledon last year.

AMANDA ANISIMOVA highlights

- 22nd WTA Tour quarter-final, and 4th of 2025. Reached just 2 in 2024.
- 5th WTA Tour quarter-final on grass, and 1st since 2022 Wimbledon. Owns win-loss record of 0-4 in grass court quarter-finals.
- 6th WTA 500 quarter-final, and 2nd of 2025 (Charleston).
- Bids to reach 10th WTA Tour semi-final, and 3rd of 2025, which would be career-best total of semi-finals in a season.
- Bids to reach 1st ever WTA Tour semi-final on grass.
- Bids to reach 3rd WTA 500 semi-final – previous two at Charleston on clay (2022, 2025).
- Won 3 WTA Tour titles, most recently at WTA 1000 Doha in February, defeating Jelena Ostapenko in final.
- Owns 10-24 win-loss record against top 10 players (2-1 record in 2025). 1st ever match against top 10 player on grass.
- Won girls' singles title at 2017 US Open, defeating Coco Gauff in final.
- Owns 4-1 win-loss record against Americans on grass. Like Navarro, defeated Gauff at Wimbledon (2022).
- Currently playing at career-high ranking of No. 15.
