On Court Team Captains Code of Conduct

Please complete this form and hand to the Referee

- Team Captains are permitted on court to advise their players during matches
- 2. Team Captains presence on court is optional and they do not have to be on court for the whole match
- 3. Team captains or their nominated deputy are allowed to communicate with their players at set breaks within the 2 minute break and must leave the court once play resumes
- Team Captains must not communicate with the opponent or the opponent's Team Captain at any time during the match
- 5. Any problems on court must be raised by the player to the Referee. The Team Captain must not enter into any discussion with the Referee unless approached and may not raise issues themselves
- 6. If the Referee deems a Team Captain's presence is detrimental to the match they will be asked to leave immediately and discussion will not be entered into until after the rubber
- 7. Team Captains may not enter into any discussion with any other Team Captain whilst on court
- 8. When there is more than one Team Captain/adult accompanying the team, only the nominated team captain will be allowed on court during matches. However, this person can nominate a deputy to replace them on court. Only one captain can be on court for a match unless the Referee permits otherwise
