## **GB NATIONAL RANKINGS**

## **ITF WORLD TENNIS TOUR**

An ITF national ranking can be assigned to British players who do not have an international ranking but wish to compete in ITF World Tennis Tour tournaments. This ranking serves as an order of merit for tournament acceptance. The GBR national rankings are determined as outlined below.

A maximum of 500 players of each gender permitted A maximum of 4 submissions per year (sent to the ITF the 1<sup>st</sup> week of each quarter)

- 1. Export of players ordered according to ITF World Tennis Number.
- 2. Players with more than 10 ATP/WTA ranking points are excluded.
- 3. Players aged 35 or older are excluded.
- 4. Those currently listed by another country as determined by ITF excluded.
- 5. List sorted by ITF World Tennis Number.
- 6. Players with LTA Combined Ranking in the open age group inside the top 100 included.
- 7. Players who have the same ITF World Tennis Number with the same ranking will be ranked the same (WTN to 1 decimal place).
- 8. List of 500 males & females submitted to ITF.

## **ITF WORLD TENNIS TOUR JUNIORS**

Since the ITF World Tennis Tour Juniors acceptance criteria recognises the ITF World Tennis Number of players after the ITF Junior World Ranking the LTA will no longer be submitting a National Ranking list.

The ITF will only consider a player who has a verified ITF World Tennis Number.

## **TENNIS EUROPE JUNIOR TOUR**

A TE national ranking can be assigned to British players who do not have a TE ranking. Players without a Tennis Europe ranking are listed in LTA ranking order in accordance with the age group that the player is entered. To be ranked in Tennis Europe events your name on the Tennis Europe system MUST match your name as it appears on your LTA profile.
