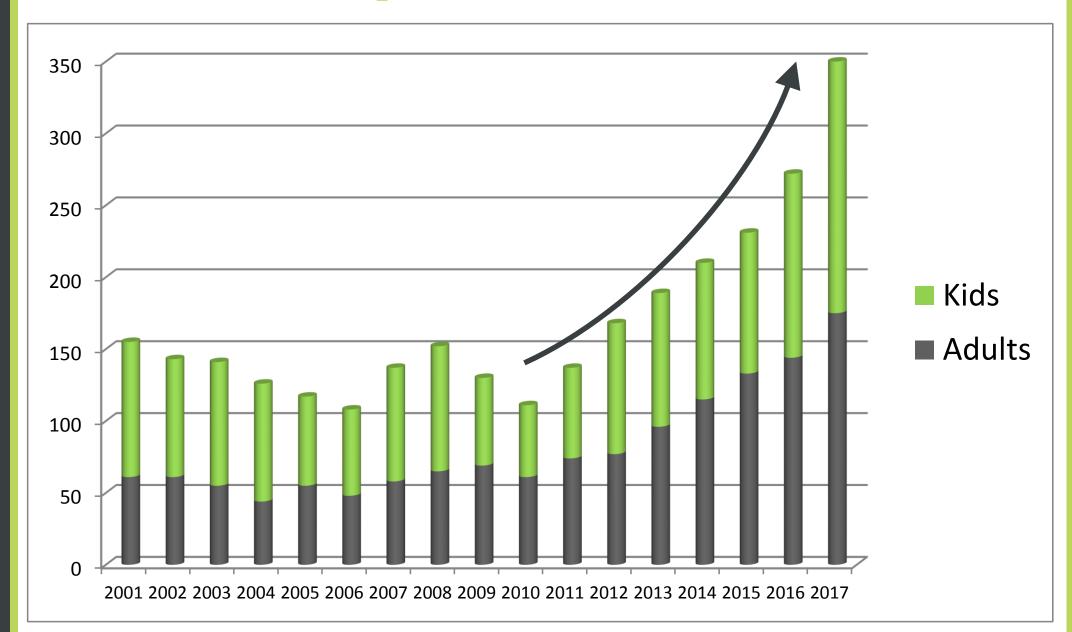

- Dynamic and innovative Coaching Programme



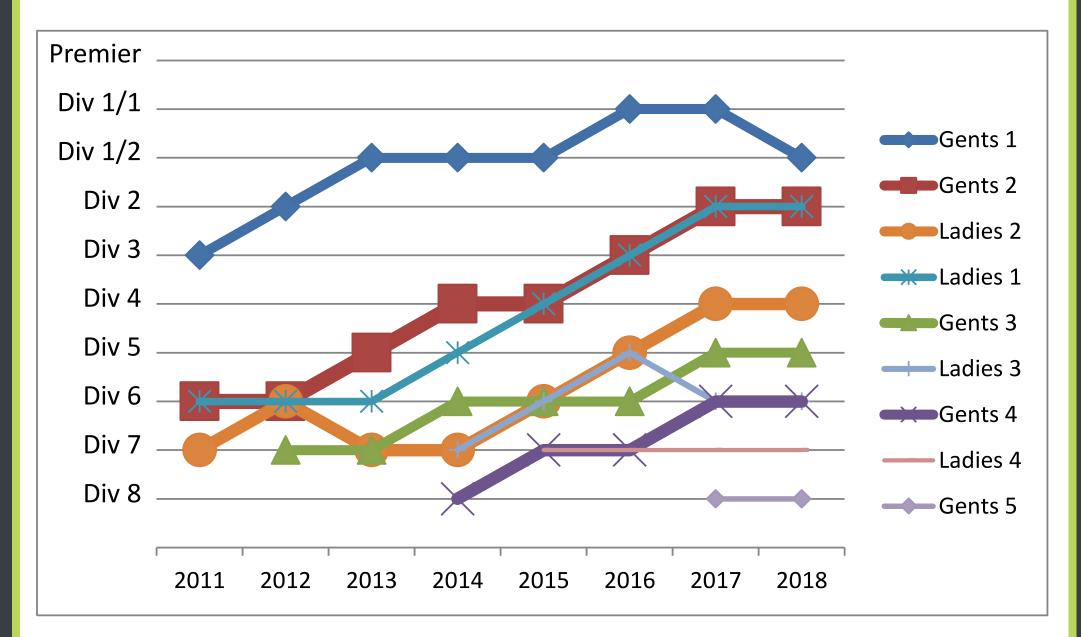

- Works completed successfully and courts opened in August

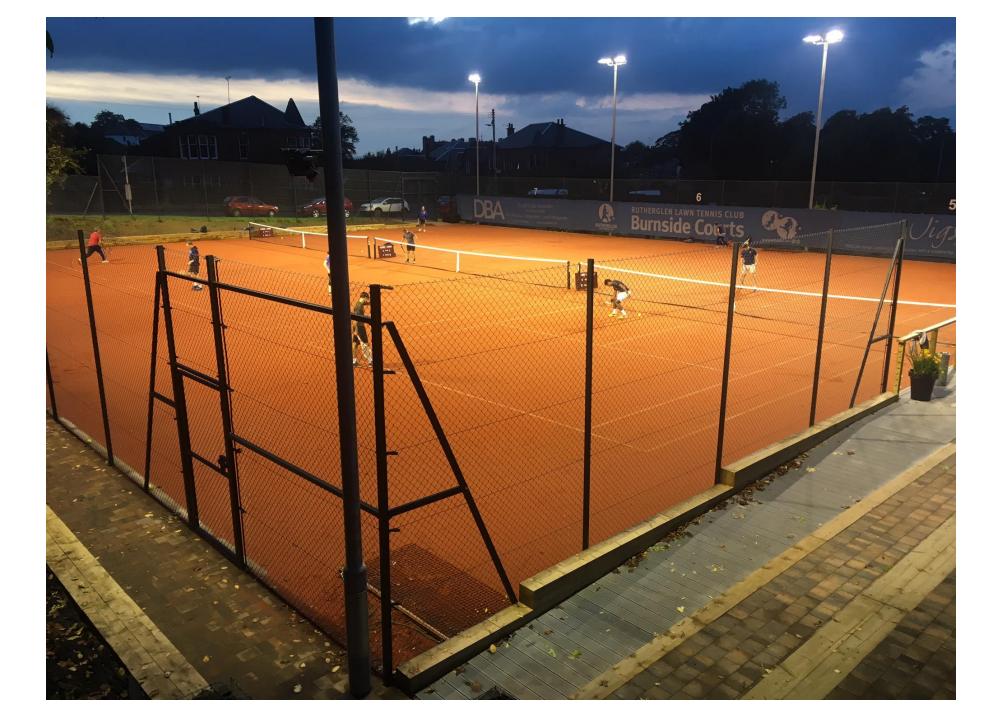








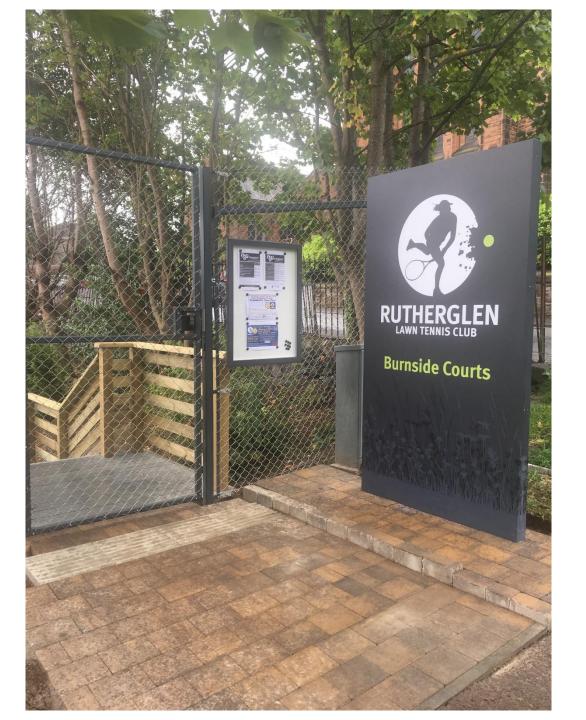






























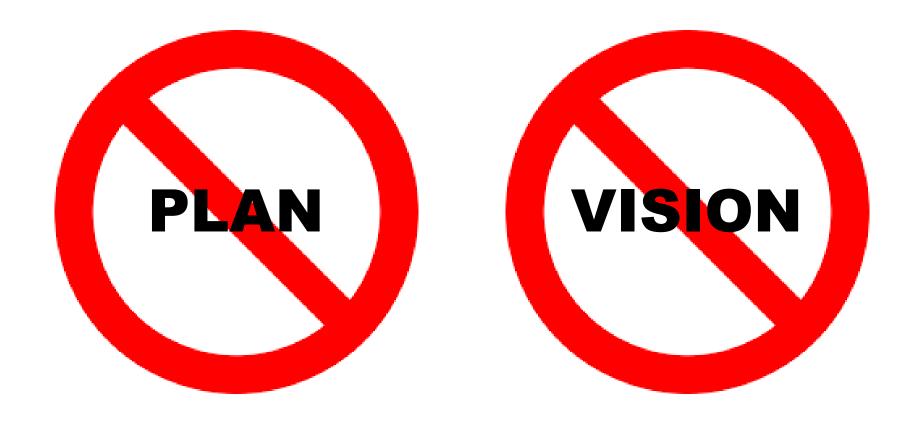

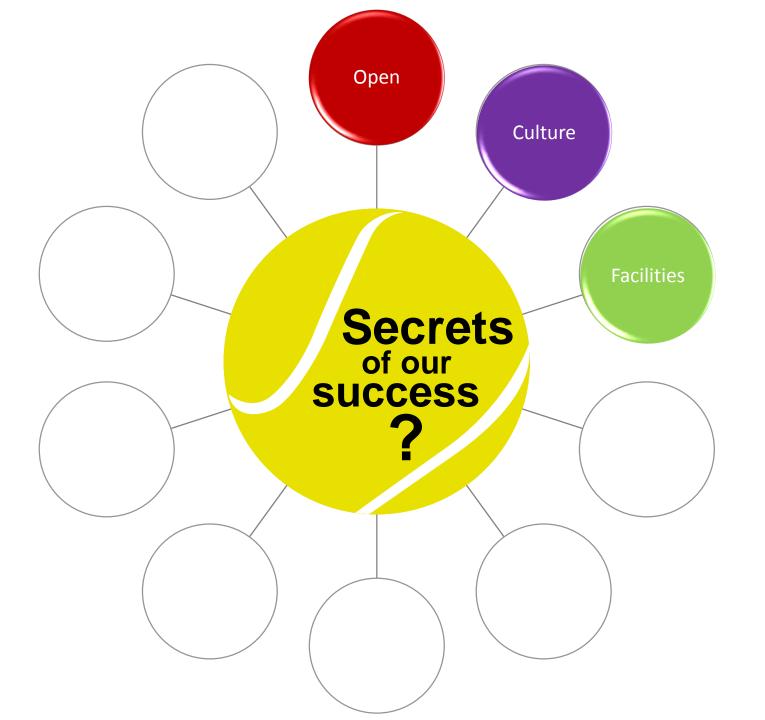


- Embed these as your club values.
