About the Role

The LTA's vision is "Tennis Opened Up" and its mission is to make tennis Relevant, Accessible, Welcoming and Enjoyable. The Major Events Team deliver the LTA's programme of world- class tournaments, driving visibility and enjoyment of tennis to new and existing audiences.

As a **Volunteer Driver**, you will play a vital role in the smooth operation of the Lexus Birmingham Open. You will be responsible for providing safe, reliable, and friendly transport services for players, coaches, officials, VIPs, and other accredited personnel. You will be one of the first points of contact for many key stakeholders, representing both the Tournament and the LTA with professionalism and warmth.

Reporting to the Volunteer Manager and Transport Manager, Volunteer Drivers will be trained in tournament transport processes and will operate scheduled journeys, ad-hoc trips, and venue-to-hotel shuttles using LTA-approved Lexus vehicles.

Key Accountabilities

- Provide a friendly, professional, and welcoming service to all passengers.
- Safely transport players, officials, VIPs, media and staff between hotels, the practice court, the competition venue, and other approved tournament locations.
- Ensure all journeys follow the Transport Team's scheduling, route guidance, and accreditation requirements.
- Maintain excellent timekeeping to support the smooth running of match schedules and stakeholder commitments.
- Assist passengers with luggage and equipment when required.
- Communicate clearly with the Volunteer/Transport Manager regarding pick-ups, delays, incidents, or schedule changes.
- Ensure vehicles are kept clean, presentable, and refuelled as directed.
- Adhere to all Tournament driving policies, including speed limits, vehicle checks, and safe-driving protocols.
- Support the coordination of player and official movements during busy periods.
- Offer basic local knowledge and general event information to passengers where appropriate.
- Represent the Tournament with a calm, courteous, and professional demeanour at all times.



General Requirements

- Must have a full, clean driving license and be over 25 years old.
- Work cohesively with other teams including Player Services, Event Management and Security to ensure smooth and secure movement of players and officials.
- Ability to adapt driving to suit different vehicle types (cars, minibuses, vans)
- Proactively problem solve and escalate any transport-related issues to ensure timely resolution.
- Follow all Tournament Health & Safety and vehicle operating guidelines, including immediate reporting of any accidents, near misses, or vehicle issues.
- Comply with the LTA's Volunteer Code of Conduct and uphold its values throughout the Tournament.
- Maintain confidentiality, particularly regarding player locations and travel details.
