Entry criteria	<p>Entries are open to players who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - hold a Welsh qualification i.e. are qualified under LTA Rules 35 & 37 to play for Wales, or; - are a member of a Registered Tennis Venue in Wales <p>Players may enter a maximum of 3 events.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1 Singles event - 1 Ladies/Mens Doubles event - 035 Mixed Doubles <p>Players may enter singles only or one/both Doubles only.</p>
Scoring formats	<p>All matches will be best of 2 tie-break sets & match tie-break.</p> <p>Doubles will adopt a No advantage deuce to be used (Receiver's choice) in all matches</p> <p>The event will be run in accordance with the ITF Rules of Tennis</p>
Categories & Draw formats	<p>Ladies Singles and Doubles O35; O45; O55; O65 Men's Singles and Doubles O35; O45; O55; O65 Open Mixed Doubles O35</p> <p>All singles events will be an elimination draw with consolation. If entries are lower than expected round robin boxes may be used at the discretion of the tournament referee.</p> <p>All doubles events will be an elimination draw with NO consolation. If entries are lower than expected round robin boxes may be used at the discretion of the tournament referee.</p> <p>Players may enter Doubles requesting a partner</p>

Order of play Subject to entry numbers and weather	<p>All competitors should be available on all three days, but let us know if this is not possible upon entry and we will try to be as flexible as possible.</p> <p>Friday 14th August – 5/6pm onwards</p> <p>Saturday 15th August – 10am to 5/6pm</p> <p>Sunday 16th August – 10am to 3/4pm</p>
Venue	<p>All matches will take place at David Lloyd Club Cardiff. Matches will predominantly take place on the outdoor courts. Indoor back-up will be available if required.</p> <p>Outdoor court surfaces to be used include artificial grass, acrylic.
