

Tournament Bonus Scheme (TBS)

In 2020 due to the Covid-19 pandemic the TBS was amended and enhanced. The enhanced package will continue until further notice.

Due to further on going restrictions and additional costs associated with travel (e.g. Covid testing) we have made further enhancements to the TBS for events as of May 3rd 2021. Below is the information for the TBS for the period May 3rd 2021 till December 31st 2021. The additional changes are highlighted in green on the table.

The TBS will continue to form a part of the LTA Support Programme in 2021 (full details of the LTA Support Programme are available here: <https://www.lta.org.uk/play/player-pathway/players/>). This scheme is designed to help facilitate and support the success of players who are achieving relevant results on the international stage.

The details of the 2021 Tournament Bonus Scheme are shown in the table below:

Please note that the amounts shown in the table for each round are the total amounts for reaching that round and are not in addition to the amount(s) shown for the previous round(s).

For doubles bonus the amount shown is per player.

The additional enhancements in green are only effective for events from 3rd May onwards and they cannot be retrospectively claimed for events prior to that date.

*For the period of time that the enhanced bonus scheme is in place (until December 31st 2021) there will be no cap on \$15K bonuses for players 23 or over.

**R32 bonuses at Women's \$60k or higher and Men's ATP Challenger only eligible if players have come through qualifying draw

Eligibility

The TBS is open to any player not in receipt of a Pro-Scholarship Programme (PSP) or Men's & Women's Programme (MWP) player funding agreement and to be eligible all players must:

1. Adhere to the LTA Player Code of Conduct;
2. Complete the LTA's Anti-Corruption and Anti-Doping Tutorials; and
3. Be eligible to represent Great Britain at either Davis Cup or Billie Jean King Cup.

If eligible, then players must confirm they have read the Code of Conduct and will adhere to it and complete the Anti-Corruption and Anti-Doping Tutorial annually. Once complete, players must complete the [TBS Invoice Template](#) and return this to the LTA with a copy of the draw sheet. All invoices must be submitted before 31st December of the year they fall in or bonuses will not be paid.

All invoices must be submitted within 3 months of the tournament.

All players must be eligible to represent GB in Davis Cup/BJK Cup at time of competition & at time of claiming.
