



Opportunity for Coaching and program delivery at Public Tennis Courts at Rossendale and Hyndburn:

Rossendale Borough Council and Hyndburn Borough Council are inviting expressions of interest from individuals, clubs, businesses, or community organisations to deliver a well-rounded tennis coaching activation programme that incorporates opportunities for all ages and abilities including coaching, inclusive activities and community outreach.

This is a unique opportunity to play a key role in promoting sport, recreation, and healthy lifestyles in the community.

There are 9 tennis courts in total, 3 at Oakhill Park in Hyndburn, 2 at Whitaker Park and 3 at Stubbylee Park in Rossendale. These courts have benefited from significant investment from the Lawn Tennis Association (LTA) to the tune of £156,643 resulting in the courts being in excellent condition to deliver coaching and activation.

The courts use the LTA ClubSpark software to manage court bookings and Smart Access Gate Technology for managing access onto court. This allows the online bookings, payments and access to the public courts.

We are seeking proposals from parties who can satisfy the following minimum requirements:

- Offer inclusive and affordable coaching and activation access for players of all ages and abilities;
- Deliver coaching and activation programme incorporating opportunities for all ages and abilities, inclusive activities and community outreach to groups who don't currently participate.
