**Zizou Bergs** | Age: 27 | World No. 48 | Career-High No. 38 | 2026: 13-14 (Eastbourne Final) | Eastbourne: 4-1 ('26 F)  
> Former World No. 12 junior broke into Top 200 in July 2021, Top 100 in June 2024 and achieved career-high No. 38 in May 2026 soon after run to Aix-en-Provence Challenger final.

> Advanced to 2024 Roland Garros 3R as Q and 2025 US Open 3R and earned Top 10 wins over No. 9 Rublev at 2025 ATP Masters 1000 Miami and No. 5 Auger-Aliassime to help Belgium to 2026 United Cup SF.

> Earned personal-best 31 wins in 2025, reached ATP Tour finals in Auckland and 's-Hertogenbosch and saved 2 MPs vs. Diallo in 4R to reach his 1st ATP Masters 1000 QF in Shanghai.

> Received 2022 Wimbledon WC after defeating former World No. 8 Sock for 2022 Ilkley Challenger title as Q.

> Also won Challenger titles at 2021 St. Petersburg-1 as Q, 2021 Lille as Q, 2021 Almaty, 2023 & 2024 Tallahassee, 2023 Drummondville and 2023 Yokkaichi.

**NOTE:** Bergs entered Eastbourne on a 6-match tour-level losing streak and now seeks his first ATP Tour title (0-2) after losing in finals of Auckland (to Monfils) and 's-Hertogenbosch (to Diallo), both last year. He is No. 39 on PIF ATP Live Rankings and would rise to career-high No. 37 by becoming first Belgian man to win a tour-level title on grass (0-5 in finals). He is 10-25 vs. Top 30, 3-5 this season after defeating No. 5 Auger-Aliassime and No. 18 Mensik at United Cup and No. 15 Rublev in Monte-Carlo. Belgium is set to also face Humbert in Wimbledon 1R next week.

**Ugo Humbert** | Age: 28 | World No. 30 | Career-High No. 13 | 2026: 24-16 (2 Finals) | Eastbourne: 6-2 (2026 Final)

> Broke into Top 20 in November 2023 and achieved career-high No. 13 in April 2024 soon after winning Dubai, joining Gulbis and Klizan as third player in Open Era to win 6th ATP Tour title in 6th final (now 7-4 in finals).

> Went on a 13-match winning streak on French indoor hard courts, capturing titles at 2023 Metz and 2024 Marseille and equaling biggest win of career over No. 2 Alcaraz en route to 1st ATP Masters 1000 final at 2024 Paris.

> Upset No. 6 A. Zverev and No. 7 Rublev en route to 3rd of 7 career titles at 2021 Halle.

> Won 1st ATP Tour title at 2020 Auckland as 21-year-old to become youngest French champion since Gasquet, 21, at 2007 Mumbai and saved 4 MPs vs. Evans en route to 2nd ATP Tour title at 2020 Antwerp.

> Earned 14 wins vs. Top 10, including biggest win of career over No. 2 Medvedev at 2022 ATP Cup.

> Defeated former No. 3 Thiem 6-3 6-0 to win 7th Challenger title of career at 2022 Rennes and in May 2023 earned 8th and 9th Challenger titles in Cagliari and Bordeaux in a 3-week span.

**NOTE:** Humbert, who turned 28 on Friday, aims to capture his 8th ATP Tour title (7-4 in finals), first since Marseille last year, and second on grass (2021 Halle). He would be the second French ATP Tour champion this season after Fils (Barcelona) and first French men's champion in Eastbourne since Llodra in 2010. He would also become the first left-handed men's champion at this event since M. Zverev in 2018 to pass Norrie to No. 29 on [PIF ATP Live Rankings](#). Frenchman held in 46 of his 47 service games this week, lone break conceded vs. Bellucci in 1st set of his 1R match.
