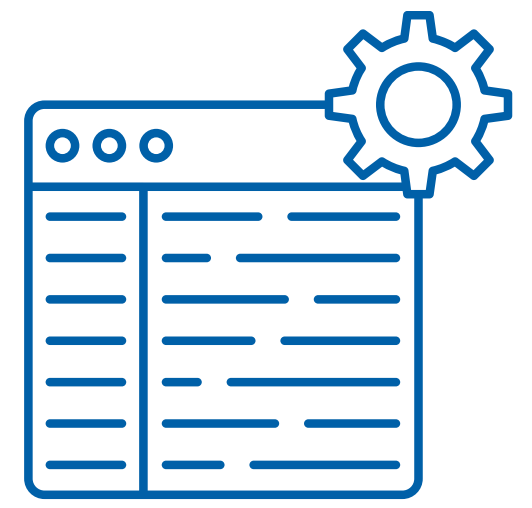

Tennis Scotland are inviting applications for our exciting Coach Development Apprenticeship Programme

ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

The 12-month, full-time programme is designed to nurture ambitious young coaching talent and lay down a pathway towards a career in tennis. Previous apprentices have become coaches and head coaches in Scottish clubs and venues, with other opportunities arising in competition management and sport development. The apprentices will join during a landmark period for tennis in Scotland, where club membership is at an all-time high, and will contribute to Tennis Scotland's mission of increasing accessibility, creating stronger venues, delivering a range of quality events and competitions, and building a world-class player development pathway.

APPRENTICE REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Under the age of 20
- ✓ Work 25 hours per week at chosen venue
- ✓ Valid PVG/safeguarding
- ✓ National 5 Maths or English (or equivalent)



AS A SPONSOR WE WILL...

- Support the CDA fully in their coaching and educational development including the youth work requirements.
- Provide a suitable working environment which should include access to computer and printing facilities.
- Allow the candidate to attend training days set up by Tennis Scotland and other National events as agreed.
- If it is agreed that the CDA will enter a second year of Apprenticeship – to pay an increased sponsorship fee in line the National Minimum Wage.
- Support the candidate fully in completion of their SVQ portfolio.



Provide a suitable mentor (Development Officer)



Complete a monthly review with the CDA



Provide a regular, varied learning programme



Provide appropriate transport where required



Provide appropriate coaching equipment



Provide a weekly schedule of work activities

AS AN EMPLOYER WE WILL...

- Contract the CDA with Tennis Scotland with appropriate company benefits
- Pay the CDA on a monthly basis, (paid by BACS last Friday of each month)
- Provide appropriate training which will include First Aid, Referee, Child Protection, Working with Children, Adult Coaching, LTA Assistant (L1) or LTA Instructor (L2) or LTA Coach Award (L3) Coaching Qualifications and other Tennis Coaching CPD workshops
- For personal development purposes, provide the opportunity to participate in National Tennis Events e.g. Coaches Conference / Pro Series Tournaments

Complete a quarterly review with the CDA



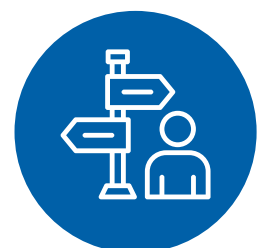
Provide additional support where necessary
