

TENNIS WALES SPECIFIC AWARD CATEGORIES 2027

OPEN FOR EXTERNAL NOMINATIONS

TEAM OF THE YEAR :

This category is aimed at recognising Welsh teams who have had an outstanding 2026. For example they may be Welsh national team achievements; junior, open, or seniors county team triumphs as well as Welsh clubs/schools/university/college teams successes at a national level.

OUTSTANDING PLAYER PROGRESS AWARD :

This category recognises continued individual player progress throughout the year for Welsh players on court whether tennis or padel. It is open to male or female (senior or junior), including players with a physical or learning disability, who have made significant improvements evidenced by their performance at National and/or International standard during 2026. (Players must be eligible to represent Wales).

PADEL PLAYER OF THE YEAR :

This category recognises the success of Welsh players on court in padel. It is open to male or female (senior or junior), including players with a physical or learning disability, who have played competitively at Regional, National and/or International standard during 2026. (Players must be eligible to represent Wales).

CLUB LEAGUE TEAM OF THE YEAR :

This category recognises a North or South Wales League Team who have had an exceptional 2025-26 winter and/or 2026 summer season. This could include registered venue teams who have remained unbeaten in their division/league, teams who have gained consecutive promotions or a team that have celebrated an outstanding achievement during the year.

TENNIS WALES PRESIDENT'S AWARD :

This award is for an individual or group that has achieved something unique, exceptional and impactful in the last year, that does not fit into another LTA or Tennis Wales Awards Category. The recipient could also be selected from an alternative category and at the discretion of the Tennis Wales President.

CLOSED FOR EXTERNAL NOMINATIONS

PLAYER OF THE YEAR :

The winner chosen by Tennis Wales, as a result of overall achievement in tennis at both National and International standard throughout 2026.
