

YOUNG PERSON'S WELFARE AMBASSADOR

YPWAs can choose the tasks they wish to complete throughout the year.

There are 5 themes, each with a choice of 3 tasks. YPWAs must choose a minimum of 1 task from each theme. Talk to your YPWA about these and how you both think you can implement them.

They can record their progress including uploading evidence onto LTA Learn and when they are happy with it, they can submit for review.

THEME	TASK
Awareness – raising the profile of safeguarding and welfare	Create a safeguarding and/or junior noticeboard
	Review and update your venue website to include a safeguarding page
	Create and share safeguarding social media messages via your venue social media channels (create one if they don't have one)
Communication – ways of sharing safeguarding and welfare information	Develop a junior newsletter that includes safeguarding information
	Create a podcast for the venue with juniors involved
	Develop an induction pack for juniors which includes safeguarding
Engagement – ways to involve venue users in safeguarding and welfare	Create ways for juniors to feedback about their experiences
	Run a safeguarding quiz/event at the venue
	Run a safeguarding info session for coaches, volunteers and staff
Culture – demonstrating the importance of safeguarding throughout all aspects of the venue	Start a junior committee to help give juniors a voice
	Present at committee meetings to raise the profile of safeguarding and explore how they can support further
	YPWA and Welfare Officer to attend coaching sessions to introduce themselves and highlight key safeguarding information
Values – underpinning behaviours and attitudes to support the importance of safeguarding	Develop and promote a code of conduct for juniors
	Embed the Safe to Play campaign in the venue
	Feed into safeguarding risk assessments for any events/competitions and/or promote safeguarding information
